Description

Patrick Hennessy (b. Cork, Ireland, 1915 and d. 1980) studied at the Dundee College of Art and Hospitalfield Advanced Art College in Arbroath, Scotland. He exhibited regularly at the RHA and had several solo shows including a retrospective at the Dublin Painters Gallery in 1951; a London show in 1956; and the Ritchie Hendriks Gallery in 1957.
