3 "Arrangements" The third and final work produced for this show consists of three square wooden frames each of which measure 4 ft by 4 ft. The interior aspect of each square is painted matt black. This work involved building a structure from floor to wall using all three square frames. Similar to a stack or building blocks, this work brings the eye up from the floor and on to the wall. The stack frames the architecture of the space and highlights or refocuses

certain built aspects. The technique employed in the construction of these frames, reference the tradition of framing art works. The negative space between the structure and the wall/floor becomes as important as the frames and once again endeavours to create a situation where definition of space and that experience comes in to question.
