### Description

As per works by Elaine Sturtevant, the collector has the option to install this video in a number of options, as follows. 1. Rotating Projector using a slow-rpm powered turn-table. The powered turntable should have a 50kg

load capacity with sliding contact power (to power the projector and media player) like this one:

Mounted on the ceiling, the collector can decide to project onto the room walls in 360 degrees.

Alternatively, one can point the projector down and project in 360 degrees onto the floor. • Mounted on the floor or a plinth, the collector can decide to project onto the room walls in 360 degrees. Floor is not an option in this mode. Note: Projector must be Full HD 1080 – Not720p/HD-Ready. Audio can come from the projector speakers. Regarding future technologies, 4k and 8k upwards projectors should be fine if they can play 1080 resolution images. 2. TV Screen Installation. This video can also be installed using 3 (three) TV screens in an inverted pyramid formation. (TVs must be a minimum of 50" Diagonal Full HD 1080 – Not720p/HD-Ready). The TVs show the same video stream from one media player using a HDMI splitter. Like in this diagram: (See artist questionnaire for diagram)
