Participants were found, through my extended network of peers and from call outs online. Each cheese is named after the individual participant who allowed me to visit their rental home and take samples. The installation of Spoiled Spores includes a 9 minute film shot in 4k, which documents the provenance of the mould and cheese-making process with menus outlining rental fees and ingredients lists which include black mould. Spoiled Spores was exhibited as a solo exhibition of the same name at the Lab Gallery November 2019-January 2020 curated by Sheena Barrett. Previously it was exhibited at the 2019 Goldsmiths MFA Degree Show where it was awarded the Goldsmiths MFA Award with Acme Studios in London.
