## Description

These works are black ceramic tablets which can be mounted on the wall with accompanying ceramic brackets. These works were first exhibited as part of the “Architecture of Change” exhibition curated by Mary Cremin in Void, Derry May-July 2018. They were exhibited again for the Architecture Book Fair at Temple Bar Gallery curated by Michael Hill November 2018. Andreas Kindler Von Knobloch is a Dublin-based artist whose practice embraces collectivity and participation through the creation of structures, objects and spaces that question material and social relations. ‘We Build a Framework’ is a new project developed for Black Mountain. Drawing inspiration from steel framework construction - a contemporary system of building that allows for maximum internal flexibility and open space - Andreas seeks to find parallels between the organisational structure of Catalyst and architectural support systems. Through a public, hands-on-event Andreas will explain and demonstrate with the participants the working principles of the structure and its potentials combinations.
