Description

Against A Melancholy Moment (or Magic Carpet) is a large floor based painting which consists of 63 individually hand painted plywood wedges. The unit shape is an upscaled canvas wedge/key; a modest functional component usually found on the reverse of a conventionally stretched canvas and used to increase tension at the corners. The piece was developed specifically for Rathfarnham Castle's unrestored, dining room hearth, for A More Immortal Atlas; a solo exhibition by Orla Whelan at Rathfarnham Castle, OPW in August – September 2020. It was subsequently exhibited at the 6th Biennial Painting in Zagreb, Croatia.
